Each year, one fellowship is awarded by the Alcatel-Lucent Foundation and Rutgers University to an incoming PhD student in the area of **Experimental or Theoretical Condensed Matter Physics**. This Fellowship provides a unique opportunity for a gifted student to pursue cutting-edge research in close collaboration with both academic and industrial scientists. Each Fellow will have an advisor at Rutgers and a mentor at Alcatel-Lucent Bell Laboratories. To the incoming student receiving this award, the Fellowship provides a generous annual stipend of \$30,000 plus health benefits and tuition remission for a period up to five years subject to yearly performance reviews. Applicants to the Rutgers Graduate Program in Physics & Astronomy who plan to pursue research in Condensed Matter Physics should indicate their interest in competing for this prestigious fellowship on their graduate application form.
