- Astro does well when the whole agency does well...sort of

 Flow of money guite different
 - NASA: fix problems; firewall?
 - NSF: science by the pound + MREFC

Astro Policy (con't)

- Center/facility politics usually consumes all the lobbying oxygen
 - AAS & many universities spend extra effort advocating for research & competed mission/facility lines
- "Balance" isn't an easy sell
- Who cares about our issues?
 - NASA & NSF are independent agencies, which is good and bad
 - DOE has bigger fish to fry
- MREFC changes afoot?





"The future of science funding will depend on many things beyond your control — the macroeconomic situation, the nature of competing needs, etc. But it will also depend on how actively you can make people like me understand why what you're about is important to our nation."

"Congress is not besieged by groups" asking for money that they describe as necessary to help their own narrow interests in the short run. The argument that science funding is a long-term national investment does nothing to set scientists apart. All that sets you apart is that scientists are the only group that thinks they're making a unique argument."
